Why cultivating rice in Austria? We will go to the farm of Georg Neumeyer who has been cultivating rice in Austria since 2015. He will show us his farm and we will be talking about innovations in agriculture, production techniques and the role the family plays in pioneering enterprises.

Himmelkeller – Hermann Bauch Museum

The Hermann Bauch Museum is an art&culture collection focused on the role of bread & wine in the region of Weinviertel. Situated in a rare type of wine-cellar, the museum uses various objects, pictures and stories to elaborate on the way of life in Weinviertel.
