The *Austrian Journal of Agricultural Economics and Rural Studies* publishes original contributions in German and English. Both, papers from basic research as well as from applied sciences are welcome. In particular, the journal aims to promote scientists at the beginning of their careers. It provides a high-quality publication opportunity for research including outstanding master's theses and dissertation projects. Submissions must correspond to the journal's focus. Only original research papers are accepted which have not been submitted or published elsewhere. Manuscripts are limited to a maximum of 4,000 words (including graphics, tables and references). All submissions are subject to a double-blind peer-review process with at least two reviewers.

It is important for the ÖGA to make knowledge accessible to an interested general public, therefore the journal is made available free of charge on the ÖGA website.
